Age determination	As at 8 th July 2017. Minimum age is 8 years
Entries	<p>All entries must be submitted through the online link</p> <p>PLEASE CLICK HERE FOR LINK TO ONLINE ENTRIES</p> <p><u>All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer</u> (submitted on the Swimming Australia database) at the time of the Meet.</p> <p>NOTE: Total number of swimmers will be capped at 300 to fit within the time constraints of the meet.</p> <p>Swimmers will only be able to enter a maximum of 5 events for this meet, due to time constraints, as outlined in the new transition meet guidelines, provided by Swimming Queensland.</p>
Eligibility	<p>This Meet is for Swimming Gold Coast 'Competitive' registered swimmers. 'Recreational' swimmers are ineligible to enter.</p> <p>#For eligibility of Visiting swimmers <u>please read</u> 'Visiting Swimmers' below.</p>
Events	<p>As per attached Program of Events.</p> <p>Heats only will be swum in each event. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, the club reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. The club also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events.</p>
Visiting swimmers	<p>Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, from Inter-state or are Non-Australian are permitted to swim.</p> <p>A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their <u>first name</u> and the Federation they are registered with.</p> <p>Inter-State and Non – Australian swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their <u>surname</u> and the club they are registered with.</p>
Late entries	<p>Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary and a fee of \$50 per event applied.</p> <p>All enquiries regarding these entries MUST only come through the attending club's Race Secretary and not through individuals.</p>

Results	<p>1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medals will be awarded to the 3 fastest placegetters (with official times) in each Age Group in 50m events: 8 years, 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years, 16 years & Over. • Medals will be awarded to the 3 fastest placegetters (with official times) in the following Age Groups for all 100m events: 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years, 16 years & Over. • Medals will be awarded only to the fastest 3 placegetters (with official times) in each 200m event. <p>NOTE: 8 years is the minimum age for the meet</p>
Collection of medals	Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.
Rules	<p>These championships will be conducted under: the Swimming Queensland General Rules, SQ Championship By-Laws, FINA and SAL rules</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be in the marshalling area 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, competitors should be in the marshalling area at least two events ahead of the event in progress.</p>
Photography & Images	In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club approved photographers, that the images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet, and that they may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club at its discretion.
Warm-up	<p>Gates Open at 7:30am</p> <p>Warm up at 8:00am for a 9:00am start</p>
Copy of Results	A copy of results will be available on the website www.swimminggoldcoast.org.au and forwarded to Swimming Queensland
Coaches	Coaches will receive a Coaches Pack consisting of 1 x food/drink voucher & 1 program each. Each Club to nominate names of coaches attending the meet on or before the closing date for nominations (Max of 3 coaches packs/club)
Meet Programs	\$5.00 each (free for coaches). Available at the pool entrance.
Raffle Draws	Raffle tickets will be available for purchase at the pool entrance. In addition, there will be a lucky Meet Program draw on the day.
Timekeeping	Each participating club must provide timekeepers according to the roster determined by the Meet Directors. The Timekeeping Roster will be provided to the Club Race Secretaries prior to the day of the meet.
