<b>Date</b>	<b>Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2019</b>
<b>Time</b>	Gates Open at 7:30am Warm up Commences at 8:00am Competition commences at 9:00am
<b>Venue</b>	Emmanuel College, Birmingham Road, Carrara
<b>Gate Entry</b>	Adults \$5.00 each   Swimmers & Coaches free (current ASCTA cards to be shown) Entry tickets available on <a href="#">Swim Central</a>
<b>Warm Up</b>	Lanes 1 and 8 will be allocated for dives for the final 15 minutes of warm-up
<b>Nomination fee</b>	\$7.00 per event (+ Gateway Fee) - \$5.00 per 25m event (+ Gateway Fee) – includes electronic program
<b>Nominations close</b>	midnight Sunday 14 <sup>th</sup> July 2019 (via on-line entry only – Swim Central) NOTE: Total number of swimmers will be limited to 300 to fit within the time constraints of the meet. (On a first swimmer registered basis)
<b>Age determination</b>	As at 21 <sup>st</sup> July 2019. Minimum age is 6 years
<b>Entries</b>	All entries <b>must be submitted through Swim Central.</b> <b>These entries are open on <a href="#">Swim Central - Link</a>.</b> <b><u>All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer (submitted on the Swimming Australia database) at the time of the Meet.</u></b>
<b>Eligibility</b>	This Meet is for Swimming Gold Coast 'Competitive' registered swimmers. 'Recreational' swimmers are ineligible to enter. <b><i>#For eligibility of Visiting swimmers please read 'Visiting Swimmers' below.</i></b>
<b>Visiting swimmers</b>	Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, or from Inter-state are permitted to swim. A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their <u>first name</u> and the Federation they are registered with. Inter-State swimmers (not members of another Federation) must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their <u>surname</u> and the club they are registered with. Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form. There will be no manual entries accepted
<b>Events</b>	As per attached Program of Events. Heats only will be swum in each event. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, the club reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. The club also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events.
<b>Late entries</b>	<b>Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary and a fee of \$50 per event applied.</b> All enquiries regarding these entries <b>MUST</b> only come through the attending club's Race Secretary and not through individuals.
<b>Results</b>	1st, 2nd and 3rd placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medals will be awarded to the 3 fastest placegetters in each Age Group in 50m events and 100m IM: 8 years, 9 years, 10 years, 11 years.</li> <li>• Medals will be awarded to the 3 fastest placegetters in the following Age Groups for all 100m events &amp; 200m IM: 10 years, 11 years.</li> <li>• Medals will be awarded only to the fastest 3 placegetters in each 200m and 1500m freestyle events.</li> <li>• All 25m event placegetters, will receive a ribbon.</li> </ul>

<b>Collection of medals</b>	Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.
<b>Rules</b>	<p>These championships will be conducted under: the Swimming Queensland General Rules, SQ Championship By-Laws, FINA and SAL rules</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be in the marshalling area 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, competitors should be in the marshalling area at least two events ahead of the event in progress.</p>
<b>Timekeepers</b>	Timekeepers will be required to be provided by each club. A timekeeping schedule will be provided at a ratio dependent on the number of swimmers attending.
<b>Photography &amp; Images</b>	<p>In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They may be photographed by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club approved photographers;</li> <li>• That the images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet; and</li> <li>• That they may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club at its discretion.</li> </ul>
<b>Meet Mobile</b>	<p>Results may be published in near real time during this meet at the clubs discretion via the Meet Mobile application.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Results published via Meet Mobile <b>ARE NOT OFFICIAL</b> and should be used as a guide only.</li> <li>• Official meet results are printed by officials during all meets and posted in a prominent position.</li> <li>• Official results are also published within 24hrs of the completion of a meet upon the Swimming Gold Coast website event pages and later on SAL Results Central</li> </ul>
<b>Copy of Results</b>	A copy of results will be available on the website <a href="http://www.swimminggoldcoast.org.au">www.swimminggoldcoast.org.au</a> and forwarded to Swimming Queensland.
<b>Pool Compliance</b>	The Emmanuel College Pool has undertaken compliance testing and met all current competitive pool standards, as set by Swimming Australia. <b>Coaches</b>	Coaches will receive a Coaches Pack consisting of 1 x food/drink voucher & 1 program each. Each Club to nominate names of coaches attending the meet on or before the closing date for nominations (Max of 2 coaches packs/club)
<b>Raffle Draws</b>	Raffle tickets will be available for purchase at the pool entrance.
<b>Refreshments</b>	Emmanuel College Swimming Club has commissioned 3 food trucks to operate throughout the weekend. These trucks will provide a wide range of food and beverage choices.
