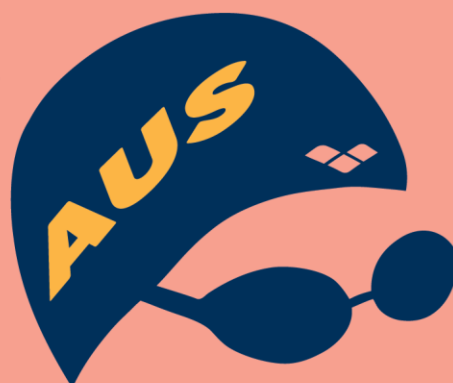

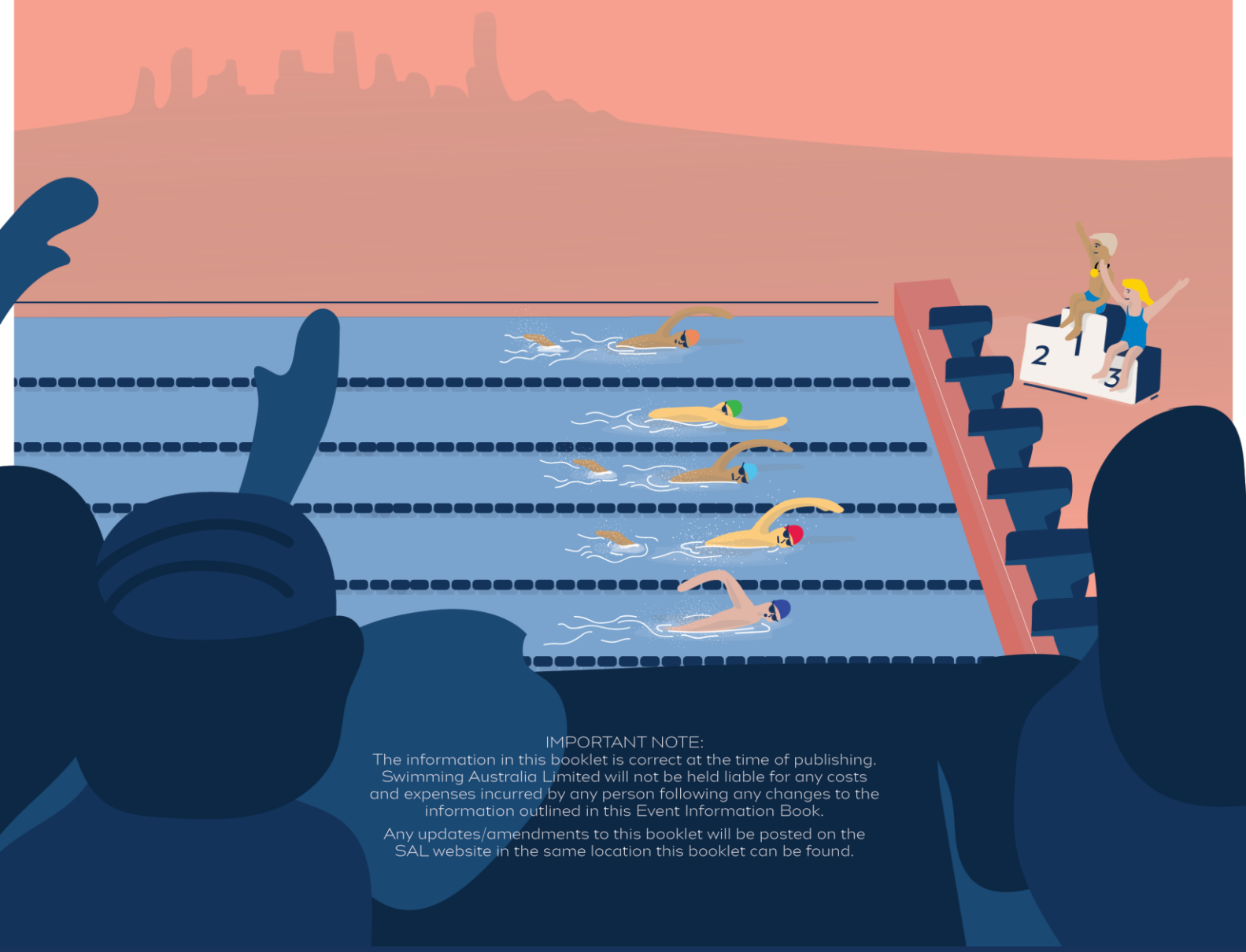

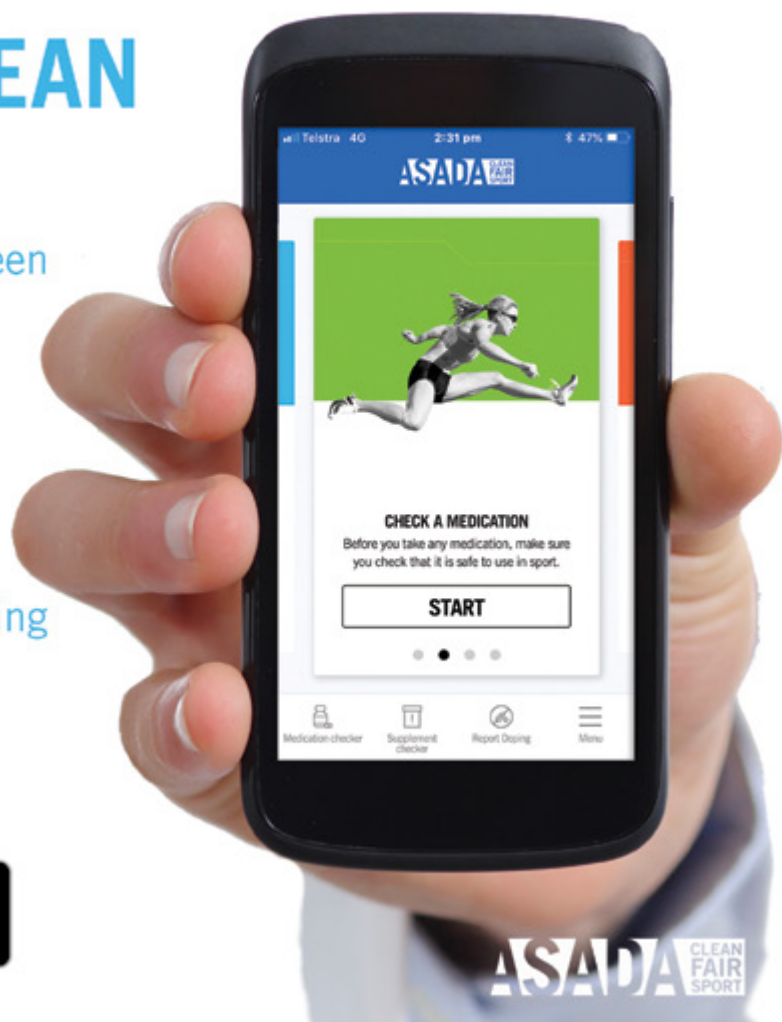

The 2019 Hancock Prospecting Australian Short Course Championships will be held at the Melbourne Sports Centres - MSAC from Thursday 24 to Saturday 26 October 2019.

A dry land warm-up area will be provided above the indoor grandstand. The Foyer overlooking the competition pool is not available for athlete use.

Lane 1	MC athletes
Lanes 2 and 8	Pace swimming (no diving)
Lane 3 – 7	Circle swimming (no diving)

Indoor warm-up pool (25m)	
Lanes 0 and 9	Dive sprints
Lane 1	MC athletes
Lanes 2 and 8	Pace swimming (no diving)
Lane 3 – 7	Circle swimming (no diving)

11. Seating

A Coaches viewing area will be available overlooking the start/finish line on the opposite side of the pool to the AOE room.

Athlete and public seating is available in the grandstand.
