<b>Venue</b>	<p>Miami Aquatic Centre 80 Pacific Aveue Miami 4220</p>
<b>Warmup</b>	Dive starts and pacework will be allocated for Lanes 0 and 9.
<b>Gate Entry</b>	<p>\$4.00 for spectators. Competitors, Coaches and children under 2 free</p>
<b>Nomination Fee</b>	<p><b>\$7.00 per event plus any processing charges</b>  <u>Includes electronic program</u>  <u>Printed programs will be provided for nominated coaches and officials</u></p>
<b>Nominations Close</b>	<p>Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November at 11.59pm or when the swimmer cap is reached  This meet is capped at 400 swimmers. (on first swimmers registered basis)</p>
<b>Age Determination</b>	Age as at 16 <sup>th</sup> November 2019
<b>Entries</b>	<p>All entries <b>must be submitted through the online link</b></p> <p><a href="#">Please Click Here for the Link to Online Entries Page</a></p> <p><i><u>Note: All Swimmers must be fully registered as a Competitive Swimmer (submitted on the Swimming Australia database) at the time of the Meet.</u></i></p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>This Meet is for Swimming Gold Coast ‘Competitive’ registered swimmers.  ‘Recreational’ swimmers are ineligible to enter.</p> <p><b><i>#For eligibility of Visiting swimmers <u>please read</u> ‘Visiting Swimmers’ below.</i></b></p>
<b>Visiting Swimmers</b>	<p>Swimmers registered to Gold Coast Clubs that are members of another Federation, or from Inter-state, are permitted to swim.</p> <p>A member of another Federation must be shown in the program with a (V) beside their first name and the Federation they are registered with.</p> <p>Swimmers must be registered in SAL Swim Central and be able to enter via the online entry form. There will be no manual entries accepted</p>

<b>Events</b>	<p>As per below Program of Events.</p> <p>Heats only will be swum in each event. If less than 3 nominations are received for an event, the club reserves the right to cancel the event and refund nominations. The club also reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events.</p>
<b>Late Entries</b>	<p><b>Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary and a fee of \$50 per event applied.</b></p> <p>All enquiries regarding these entries <b><u>MUST</u></b> only come through the attending club's Race Secretary and not through individuals.</p>
<b>Results</b>	<p>Age Champions will not be recognised.</p> <p>1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placings will be determined from the OFFICIAL TIMES swam in the heats. Medals will be awarded.</p> <p>In the all 200m &amp; 400m events excluding the 200 IM , Medals will be awarded in the following Age Groups 11&amp; 12 yrs combined, 13 years.</p> <p>In the 200 IM Medals will be awarded in 9years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years &amp; 13 years.</p> <p>In the 9-11 years 100m events medals will be awarded as a combined age group.</p> <p>In the 50m events medals will be awarded in 8 years, 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years.</p> <p>All 14 years &amp; over events will be awarded prize money as follows 1<sup>st</sup> Place \$30, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$20 and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$10.</p>
<b>Collections of Medals</b>	<p>Collection of medals is the responsibility of each swimmer. Medals &amp; Money not collected by the end of the meet will not be redeemed.</p>
<b>Rules</b>	<p>This event will be conducted under: the Swimming Queensland General Rules, SQ Championship By-Laws, FINA and SAL rules</p> <p>Competitors in the first two events should be in the marshalling area 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the session. In addition, competitors should be in the marshalling area at least two events ahead of the event in progress.</p>
<b>Timekeepers</b>	<p>Timekeepers will be required to be provided by each club. A timekeeping schedule will be provided at a ratio dependant on the number of swimmers attending.</p>

<b>Photography &amp; Images</b>	<p>In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• They may be photographed by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club approved photographers,</li> <li>• The images may be displayed for viewing and purchasing on site during the Meet and on the photographer's secure website after the Meet, and</li> <li>• They may also be used by Swimming Queensland, Swimming Gold Coast and the Club at its discretion.</li> </ul>
<b>Meet Mobile</b>	<p>Results may be published in near real time during this meet at the clubs discretion via the Meet Mobile application.</p> <p>Please note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Results published via Meet Mobile <b>ARE NOT OFFICIAL</b> and should be used as a guide only.</li> <li>• Official meet results are printed by officials during all meets and posted in a prominent position.</li> <li>• Official results are also published within 24hrs of the completion of a meet upon the Swimming Gold Coast website event pages and later on SAL Results Central</li> </ul>
